Ranging from looking at the range and effectiveness of climate change adaptation or mitigation strategies in your surrounding area, to comparing community memories of extreme weather events with data, to studying links between weather and behaviour or illness in your school or college. For those who would like to bring art into their project, there are links between weather and the colours in the sky.

The Royal Meteorological Society is also able to loan (free of charge) portable Kestrel weather stations to students for EPQ projects. Data collection and analysis can lead into an EPQ investigation / field study.
